NY State Senator Jack Martins Visits Village Discusses Grant, Tax Cap and State Affairs

NY State Senator Jack Martins visited Plandome Heights on Friday, September 5, 2014 to review the status of a public works grant that is pending as well as to discuss matters of interest to villages in NY State. Meeting with Senator Martins was Mayor Riscica, Trustees Solomon and Ferman and Clerk Arlene Drucker.

The pending grant would provide funding for a planned road resurfacing project on The Waterway/The Neck. Mayor Riscica reviewed the bid documents and plan for the project with the Senator and the Senator promised to follow up to make sure the grant approval is moving as quickly as possible. Other topics discussed included our Village's plans to continue to comply with the Tax Cap so that we are eligible for the 2015 NY State tax rebate. Additionally, the Senator brought us up to date on pending matters in the State Capital. The meeting lasted about an hour.
