Infrastructure Improvements Update in Plandome Heights

Work resumes after a three week “detour”

After a three week “detour” created by Hurricane Sandy, shovels are back in the ground in the Village of Plandome Heights for infrastructure improvements. Specifically, the Village is making improvements to contouring and grading, and adding storm drains, on Bay Driveway in order to improve drainage and protect Manhasset Bay. Once the grading and drainage improvements are made, the road will be resurfaced “curb-to-curb” from Plandome Road to Bayview Circle. NY State has provided grant funds for the project and MLWD is partnering with the Village to assist in the paving, as previously reported.

In addition, the Manhasset-Lakeville Water District (“MLWD”) is now making final connections to the new water main on Bayview Circle and Plandome Road. Nassau County owns the section of Plandome Road in the Village of Plandome Heights. As such, the County and the Village have been cooperating on a plan to pave that portion of Plandome Road (north of Webster Avenue). Given the significant delay caused by Sandy, it is now less likely that the County will pave this section of Plandome Road before the winter.
