GN/NS Cable Commissioner, and Plandome Heights Trustee, Aida Ferman celebrates the grand opening of the new PATV headquarters in Lake Success

On April 18, 2013, Public Access Television ("PATV") opened their new headquarters and studio in Lake Success. The grand opening event was attended by officials from the member villages and the Town of North Hempstead.

PATV is an affiliate of the Great Neck/North Shore Cable Commission ("GNNSCC"). The GNNSCC is the coordinating agent for the Great Neck and Manhasset Villages in awarding, monitoring and controlling the cable television franchises in our community. By working together, the individual villages coordinate one agreement with consistent terms, for the two communities. Each Village has representation on the Board of Directors of PATV and GNNSCC. In Plandome Heights, Trustee Aida Ferman has served as our village representative for many years and was in attendance for the grand opening ceremony and ribbon cutting.

PATV provides exciting opportunities for residents, non-profits and public agencies through workshops, facilitator grants and services at its newly updated television studio and production facility. PATV administers public access TV services in the 15 incorporated villages of the Great Neck/North Shore Cable Commission. PATV cablecasts programs on Channel 20 (Cablevision) and Channel 37 (Verizon). PATV is a 501(c)3 organization that is independent of the cable television providers.
