Nassau County Honors Marion Endrizzi of Plandome Heights as one of Nassau County's Outstanding Women of Achievement

On March 26, 2013, Plandome Heights Civic Association President, Marion Endrizzi, was named as one of Nassau County's Outstanding Women of Achievement. The presentation was made to Mrs. Endrizzi by County Executive Mangano in the Ceremonial Chamber of the Theodore Roosevelt Executive Building in Mineola.

Marion Endrizzi served as Village Clerk, then went on to serve as an elected Village Trustee for 14 years and then as Mayor in 2005/6. She initiated and still maintains the Village Tree Replacement program. She presently is the Chair of the VPH Planning Board. Marion works with Nassau County Dept. of Health (mosquito control) to regularly test Plandome Pond Park for West Nile disease and developed a strong relationship with the Nassau County Police Problem Oriented Police team for the benefit of the community.

She reactivated the Plandome Heights Civic Association in 2010 and serves as its President. In mid-2012, she became a member of the TONH Plandome Road Parking study committee. She is a charter member of the Plandome Heights Womens Club and serves as Chair of the Nominating Committee. She loves her town and Village and is one of the most involved individuals in our community. We are grateful to have her as part of our Nassau community.
