Subject: National Grid Excavation Work Begins Wednesday, January 19



This is an important message from Mayor Kenneth C. Riscica for residents of the Village of Plandome Heights

National Grid's contractor, Bancker Construction, will start excavating the trenches for the new gas mains starting at <u>Plandome Road at Bournedale Road North, tomorrow, Wednesday, January 19.</u> The work plan is to dig trenches of approximately 700 linear feet each day. During the trench work, the <u>road is expected to be completely closed</u> at the location of that day's work.

As a result of the road closure, residents should park their vehicles on the adjacent streets by 7:00 am on work days for your home OR the night before work is expected to take place at your home. NatGrid is contacting affected residents as each day of work passes.

We have informed NCPD <u>not</u> to issue parking summons for cars parked adjacent to each daily work area for either overnight or 3 hour limit parking. This is limited and temporary. Manhasset's school district has been notified so they can adjust their bus route, if necessary. Contingency plans are in place to accommodate emergency vehicles, if needed.

Following tomorrow's work, Bancker will move through the entire Bournedales section in succession doing 700 LF of trenching each day until all of the trenches have been dug and the gas main installed. Household connections to the new main will come later.

There is abudant information for residents on our website at <u>Capital Plan</u>. Bancker Construction is your primary contact for questions and their primary point of contact is provided on our website at <u>Bancker Construction Letter to Residents</u>. The Village has no direct responsibility or control over these activities, but will maintain close monitoring of progress and issues, if any.

Due to periodic road closings, we also ask that residents use caution in the Village for the next couple weeks, and follow the road signs provided. All construction schedules and timelines are subject to change for weather, complications, and other conditions.
