Residents:

I am expecting this current phase of the NatGrid work to come largely to conclusion by mid-March, 2022. After that, there will be a delay until early April when final tie-ins of the gas main will be done and the old main retired. The roads need to be prepared for our paving and then it has to settle before we pave.

Further, residents need to know that a new variable has been added to our plans. The Manhasset Lakeville Fire Department has determined that 12 fire hydrants in our Village require replacement.

We have a lot of work to do in addition to this and I write to give you a sense of our plans. This is not a schedule; it is our goal.


Our rough plans from March 1st forward are:

- Mid/end of March, 2022 – NatGrid completes the current phase of gas project,
- End of March, 2022 – Village sweeps the streets affected by construction,
- Middle of April, 2022 – NatGrid completes their work,
- Late March/April, 2022 –
 - o Storm drain repair/improvement on Cove at Waterway (see website),
 - o Replace broken concrete and install new asphalt entrance to Plandome Ct. N. (see website),
 - o Concrete repair at Summit and other,
- During April, 2022 – Concrete repairs to:
 - o Swales on Waterway, Beachway,
 - o Curbs in various places
- During April, 2022 – Manhasset Lakeville FD replaces 12 fire hydrants in the Village,
- May/June – Curb-to-curb paving in all of the Bournedales, Waterway, Neck, Cove, Beachway and Shore.

All construction plans are subject to change due to weather, supply chain and other factors.

This represents months of disruption and we appreciate your patience. When we are done, we will have significant infrastructure improvements and a majority of new roads. Our website has robust information on our plans, including renderings, pictures, and FAQ's so please take the opportunity to review that.
