2022 – Year in Review Planning Board

- Discussed for over 5 years
- January 2021 vote to invite residents for Public Hearing.
- February 2021, Public Hearing,
- Hundreds of pages of testimony and data,
- June 2021, Planning Board merged to BOT



2022 – Year in Review Zero Tax Increase

- Residents asked to lower proposed \$2.8% tax increase,
- Village agreed to "bend the curve" for 2 yrs.
- Two year increase = 0.7%, less than half the trend line increase,
- 2 Yr. costs up \$32,000, Taxes up \$5,000 = \$28,000 tax savings to residents (\$86/home)
- Promises kept



2022 – Year in Review Cannabis

- Governor legalizes Cannabis in March 2021
- December 31, 2021, one time only, opportunity to limit
- Public Hearing in July 2021, vote in Sept.
 2021 to accept all available limitations



LED Lights



62 total lights, 9 on Plandome Road, 53 in neighborhoods.

Approx. \$25,000 – No taxpayer money, all Parkland money from other sources

Village of Plandome Heights Digital Records

- Reached out for volunteers in April 2021
- Kristina Lobosco and Florence Musalo volunteer
- Mission "To identify digital solutions to records management and recommend a comprehensive, multi-year solution and budget"
- September 2021 First meeting
- March 2022 Grant application for \$50,000



Village of Plandome Heights Benchmarking - Taxes

- Our taxes remain 33% lower that our nearest comparable, the Town, "Outside Village" tax (saves you \$500/year on average, \$5,000 over 10 years,
- Our taxes are the <u>lowest operating taxes in Nassau</u>

 <u>County and</u>
- In NY State Villages with our tax load have 65% lower median gross income than our residents.

By any measure our tax levy is frugal.



Village of Plandome Heights Benchmarking - Costs

To benchmark our costs, we compared our costs to 4 Villages with similar populations, area and charters*; we found:

- Snow removal costs are 63% below our comparables,
- Sanitation costs are 23% below,
- Human resources are 41% below,
- Benefits are about 78% below.
- Occupancy costs are analyzed in our Budget presentation.

These costs comprise over 70% of our Tentative Budget. By any measure our cost control is strong.

Village of Plandome Heights Single Family Zoning

- In January, Governor Hochul proposed eliminating single family housing through the budget
- Same maneuver used to enact Criminal Justice/Bail Reform,
- We led the fight, with others, to get the Governor to relent
