**Plandome Heights Celebrates the Retirement of Trustees Aida Ferman,
Alvin Solomon and Dianne Sheehan**

April 3, 2022 – On April 3, 2022, the Plandome Heights Village officials hosted a brunch at the Port Washington Yacht Club to celebrate the retirement of three long-term Trustees including Silva (“Aida”) Ferman (18 years), Alvin Solomon (16 years) and Dianne Sheehan (6 years). In addition, attendees of the celebration included Mayor Kenneth Riscica, Trustees Norman Taylor, Daniel Cataldo and Gus Panopoulos as well as newly-elected Trustees Mary Hauck, Kristina Lobosco, and Florence Musalo, as well as our Building Inspector Edward Butt and our Village Clerk-Treasurer Arlene Drucker, Court Clerk Katherine A. Hannon and Interim Deputy Clerk Kathryn Gross as well as Village Attorney Christopher Prior.

After officially “retiring” the Trustee nameplates to them, Mayor Riscica presented a personal note of appreciation and a Proclamation to officially recognize each of the three honorees. Further, awards were given to each retiring Trustee as appreciation for their years of service to organizations affiliated with the Village as follows:

- Silva Ferman - North Shore Cable Commission and the Plandome Heights Women’s Club (“PHWC”).
- Alvin Solomon - Port Washington-Manhasset Office of Emergency Management
- Dianne Sheehan - Manhasset Bay Protection Committee

The president of the Plandome Heights Women’s Club, Rebecca Scaramucci, came to personally present Trustee Ferman with the PHWC award.

Mayor Kenneth C. Riscica said, “Over their long years of service, these extraordinary volunteers, helped the Village turn deficits into surplus, create low and stable taxes, create and execute on a 10-year Capital Plan, clean up all deferred maintenance, repave all the roads in the Village and build a substantial reserve fund for our future.
