RE: Propel NY Energy

Dear Friends and Neighbors:

I write to make you aware of an important infrastructure project being organized to start later this year in order to increase the availability of electric power on Long Island.

The plan is to address our growing electric needs by creating bi-directional connections to the power grid in the state and, if available, offshore. This will be done by excavating about 90 miles of important roads in North Hempstead, and elsewhere, in order to install new bi-directional electric transmission lines. Locally, the project will involve excavating Northern Boulevard from Queens to Glen Cove Road. North/south routes, like Glen Cove Road, will also be excavated. The contractor for the project is Propel NY Energy.

Recently, Supervisor DeSena held an information update meeting for the mayors, and certain business leaders, in North Hempstead. At that meeting, we learned that the project is in late stages of approval and that construction plans are being developed. The goal is to start by the end of 2026. The project is projected to take nearly 4 years and will result in serious disruptions throughout North Hempstead during that time, including motorists diverting activity onto local roads. It is currently not known when the Manhasset portion of Northern Boulevard will be done.

In addition, in an effort to increase awareness and create an opportunity for residents to understand the project and ask questions, The Propel NY Energy team will be visiting area neighborhoods for a series of Community Office Hours, bringing the latest information about the Propel NY Energy project directly to you. The Manhasset visit will be on Wednesday, February 25, 2026 at the Manhasset Library from 3 pm to 5 pm. Other dates and locations are on the reverse side of this letter.
